**Extension of time to respond to request made under the Official Information Act 1982**

Thank you for your email of 18 July 2013 requesting, under the Official Information Act 1982, information on vehicle licence plate tracking in New Zealand.

This letter is to advise you that the NZ Transport Agency (NZTA) is extending the 20 working days available to respond to your request, as allowed for under section 15A of the Official Information Act 1982. The NZTA requires an additional six working days to respond to your request. We will send you a response by 23 August 2013.

The deadline is being extended because of the consultations necessary to make a decision on your request. A proper response to your request cannot reasonably be made within the 20 working day limit.

Under section 28(3) of the Official Information Act 1982, you have the right to make a complaint to an Ombudsman about the extension. The address is:
