Official Information Act request for all correspondence between the Prime Minister or her Office and Neale Jones

Thank you for your Official Information Act 1982 (the Act) request, received on 30 May 2019. You requested:

"...all text messages, emails, and other written correspondence between you and Neale Jones, and your office and Neale Jones, sent or received between your swearing in as minister and today."

I extended the time frame for providing a decision on your request by 10 working days because it necessitated searching through a large quantity of information, and consultations were needed before a decision could be made.

Please find enclosed 14 documents as listed in the attached table.

I have decided to release the relevant parts of the documents listed above, subject to information being withheld under section 9(2)(a), to protect the privacy of individuals.

As you are aware, there have been substantial staffing changes within the Prime Minister's Office during the period of time spanned by your request. Any information within the scope of your request that may have been communications with a former staff member are no longer held by this office because it is not the type of information that is required to be retained under the Public Records Act 2005. Please find enclosed the following documents:

In making my decision, I have considered the public interest considerations in section 9(1) of the Act.

You have the right to ask the Ombudsman to investigate and review my decision under section 28(3) of the Act.

Re the PM's request to talk with Tim Cook:

- The Christchurch mosque attacks were accompanied by unprecedented activity online, with the perpetrator livestreaming the attack and orchestrating a viral online response across multiple platforms and sites.
- The PM has said that New Zealand intends to take a range of actions, domestically and in collaboration with other countries and the tech industry, to look for solutions to the problem of terrorist and violent extremist content online.
- The PM has begun working with fellow heads of government and the heads of the other major technology companies to find shared solutions to this problem.

She will seek Tim Cook's thoughts and invite him to participate in this process, including at meetings of governmental and tech industry leaders in Paris on 14-15 May, co-chaired by the PM and President Macron.

Fujitsu is sponsoring the Business NZ - EMA pre-budget luncheon on May 24 in Auckland, where the Prime Minister is the keynote speaker.


