Dear Mr Davenport

I refer to your Official Information Act request of 29 July 2019 for information relating to vehicle incidents involving Police staff that result in injuries to the public.


You requested:

- 1. For number 6, "The number of reports that involved an injury", I was more interested in the number of reports that involved an injury to anyone, not just to Police staff. I note that your response just includes the number of injuries to Police staff. I would hope that any incidents recorded also note any injuries to the public, especially as the Police appear to be at fault in a number of these incidents.*

This information is not recorded by Police. Therefore, this part of your request is refused pursuant to section 18(g) of the Official Information Act 1982, in that the information requested is not held in the form requested and Police has no reason to believe it is held by another agency.

You have the right, under section 28 (3) of the Official Information Act 1982, to ask the Ombudsman to review my decision if you are not satisfied with the way I have responded to your request.
