Response to official information request for cost of paving in the city centre

I refer to your request for official information received 14 October 2019. We have processed your request under the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act (LGOIMA) 1987.

Your questions relate to the District Plan review, and more specifically, information available on our draft District Plan webpage: porirua.govt.nz/draft-district-plan. These questions and our responses to them are outlined in the table below.

Your website currently says: "We have now released a full draft District Plan for community feedback. We want to check in with the community to ensure we have 'hit the mark' before we formally notify the Proposed District Plan under the Resource Management Act." Question: Does this mean feedback on the full draft District Plan is still open?	If anyone has questions, feedback, or would like more information about our draft District Plan we encourage them to continue to send this to our email address: dpreview@porirua.govt.nz
Your website as far as the Plan review process is concerned says: "We're here" and then refers to Sept 2019. It is now October Question: When will the website be updated?	The timeline graphic has been updated on our webpage: porirua.govt.nz/draft-district-plan
Your website implies that making a district plan is an inclusive process. However, PCC has already received comment about the draft District Plan but has not seen fit to post it on the website. Question: Will PCC post copies (in full) of feedback received on the draft District Plan on PCC's website and if not why not, and if so when will that happen.	As outlined above we are continuing to receive feedback on the draft District Plan from the community as well as key stakeholders. The draft District Plan consultation is an informal and iterative process and due to this it is not our intention to publish all feedback on our website. We will be summarising key themes in an Engagement Report which will be released early next year, sent to all submitters and published on our website.
