Thank you for your email on 30 October 2019 requesting under the Official Information Act 1982 (the OIA), the following information:

*"Can I please have access to any document/communication whether internal or external which lead to the publication of the change to how PPI's are treated for Entrepreneur Work Visa applicants who are offshore:
