## NMH response

To date, we do not appear to have received a reply to our invitation for you to consider narrowing the scope of your request to selected pathways so as to be readily retrievable. As such, NMH declines to respond under section 12(2) 'the official information requested shall be specified with due particularity in the request'.

The DHB maintains a system of clinical referral pathway tools to support Primary Care practitioners across many clinical specialties and diagnoses, including consistent guidance on when to refer for a Specialist opinion.
