Thank you for your email of 26 March 2020, requesting further information about individuals serving less than three years' imprisonment, as at 30 November 2019. Your request has been considered under the Official Information Act 1982 (OIA).

You have requested:

a breakdown of the 1,985 prisoners by their number of convictions, specifically how many are in each of the following categories:

1. 10 or fewer convictions
2. 11 to 25 convictions
3. 26 to 50 convictions
4. 50 to 75 convictions
5. 76 to 100 convictions
6. (6) 101 - 200 convictions
7. more than 200 convictions

Please refer to the table below.
