Terrorism Threat Level	
LOW	The Combined Threat Assessment Group (CTAG) assesses a terrorist attack in New Zealand is possible, but is not expected.

Summary

Domestic terrorism

- The terrorism threat levels remain unchanged from last quarter. NZSIS sighted no indications of mobilisation to violence during the reporting period, and there were no notable violent incidents or near misses.

International terrorism

- New Zealand was not directly affected by any international terrorist incidents during the reporting period, judging from information available to NZSIS. The international terrorism environment is complex, but New Zealand remains unlikely to be a direct target of terrorist groups.
