## Response to your request for official information

Thank you for your request under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act) to the Ministry of Health (the Ministry) on 9 April 2021 for:

- "1. Please provide the percentage survival rate for COVID-19 cases in New Zealand to date. That is, for people who contracted the disease, what is the official statistic for their chance of surviving COVID-19 based on how many survived the disease versus how many contracted the disease?
- 2. Please provide the average age of the people who have died from COVID-19 in New Zealand to date
- 3. Please provide the percentage survival rate for COVID-19 cases in New Zealand to date. That is, for people who contracted the disease, what is the official statistic for their chance of surviving COVID-19?"

The survival rate for COVID-19 cases in New Zealand as at 15 April 2021, is 98.9%. The average age of people who died from COVID-19 is 79 years of age as at 15 April 2021.
