Official Information Act Request – payments made to Allen + Clarke by Sport New Zealand

This letter responds to your Official Information Act 1982 (OIA) request received on 13 June 2021. In your request you asked for the following:

- *“The total amount paid to Allen + Clarke from 1 July 2020 to 31 May 2021, broken down by month;*
- *The total amount of invoices received from Allen + Clarke since 1 July 2020 that have not yet been paid;*
- *The forecast budget for expenditure with Allen + Clarke for the 2021-2022 financial year;*
- *The name/s of the projects/pieces of work that Allen + Clarke have been contracted to undertake for Sport NZ since 1 July 2020.”*

I have set out below responses to each of your questions.

The total amount paid to Allen + Clarke from 1 July 2020 to 31 May 2021, broken down by month

From 1 July 2020 to 31 May 2020 the total amount paid by Sport NZ to Allen + Clarke is set out in the table below.

I note that this is for all work carried out for Sport NZ, and not just Allen + Clarke’s work on the Guiding Principles for the Inclusion of Transgender Participants in Community Sport.

The forecast budget for expenditure with Allen + Clarke for the 2021-2022 financial year

Generally, Sport NZ does not budget for specific consultants, rather we have a budget for projects and go to market for tenders to complete the work.

The name/s of the projects/pieces of work that Allen + Clarke have been contracted to undertake for Sport NZ since 1 July 2020.

Since 1 July 2020 Allen + Clarke has undertaken the following work for Sport NZ:

- Guiding Principles for the Inclusion of Transgender Participants in Community Sport
- Active NZ review (Research survey)
- Voice of Rangatahi Report and regional RST reports (Research)
