

## SIMON DYNE



Simon grew up in Lower Hutt and attended Nae Nae College in the late 1980's and early 1990's. He was Head Boy in his final year and went on to the University of Canterbury to study engineering, which runs in his family blood. After leaving University in 1998 he worked in the forest industry for Carter Holt Harvey. He has a strong focus on encouraging diversity into the construction industry and champions looking after the true skilled workers who keep New Zealand moving. Simon attended and was inspired by the Invictus Games in 2018 and values the strong relationship between Fulton Hogan and the NZDF across New Zealand.
