Thanks for your response.

At this stage, the roll out of validators across the network is some time away. It will be done as part of the National Ticketing Solution roll out, but at present, there is no clear timeline for this from Waka Kotahi (they are currently in the process of selecting preferred vendors, but it will be some time before they are ready to agree the staging plan across the country). As such, I don't think there is any need at this time to go into more details beyond highlighting any stations that we know have current Heritage listings.

Why don't we have a quick chat about this after the meeting next week. We can also pick up on your questions Ian, about current status of some of the buildings on the Hutt Valley Line.

- Some may be scheduled or proposed for scheduling by local councils.
- Sites potentially may be pre 1900 and come under Heritage New Zealand's archaeological provisions and process.
  
- There are also places known to be heritage but not listed or scheduled.

Generally for listed places on the Heritage New Zealand List this includes platform and canopy. And sometimes an area [historic area].
