


POSTOPERATIVE PAIN: IV MORPHINE AND IV FENTANYL IN ADULTS



OPIOID MIXTURES

MORPHINE 10mg in 10ml (1mg/ml);

FENTANYL 100microg in 10ml (10microg/ml).

Prepare 10ml syringe using 0.9% sodium chloride (normal saline) as dilutent

SEDATION SCORES

- 1. Nil. Awake, alert.
- Mild. Asleep but rouses to voice.
- 3. Mod. Asleep but rouses to touch.
- 4. Severe Asleep/unrousable.
- Recovery staff to notify Anaesthetist if patient remains in pain after one entire (10ml) syringe is administered.

Consider NSAIDs or local anaesthetic technique.

Patient to remain in PACU for minimum of 15 minutes after last opioid dose.

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
