## Response to your request for official information

I will respond to each part of your request in turn.

1) A copy of this interim review

The draft interim review of the outbreak was provided to senior leadership for review on 24 December 2021. As feedback and discussion is ongoing, the interim review is refused under section $9(2)(f)$ (iv) of the Act to maintain the constitutional conventions that protect the confidentiality of advice tendered by Ministers and officials. I have considered the countervailing public interest in release in making this decision and consider that it does not outweigh the need to withhold at this time.
2) Copies of any other interim reviews of the outbreak response completed since this one."

This part of your request is refused under section 18(e) as the information requested does not exist.
