- Speed humps & cushions

- Roundabouts
- Intersection upgrades
- Street lighting

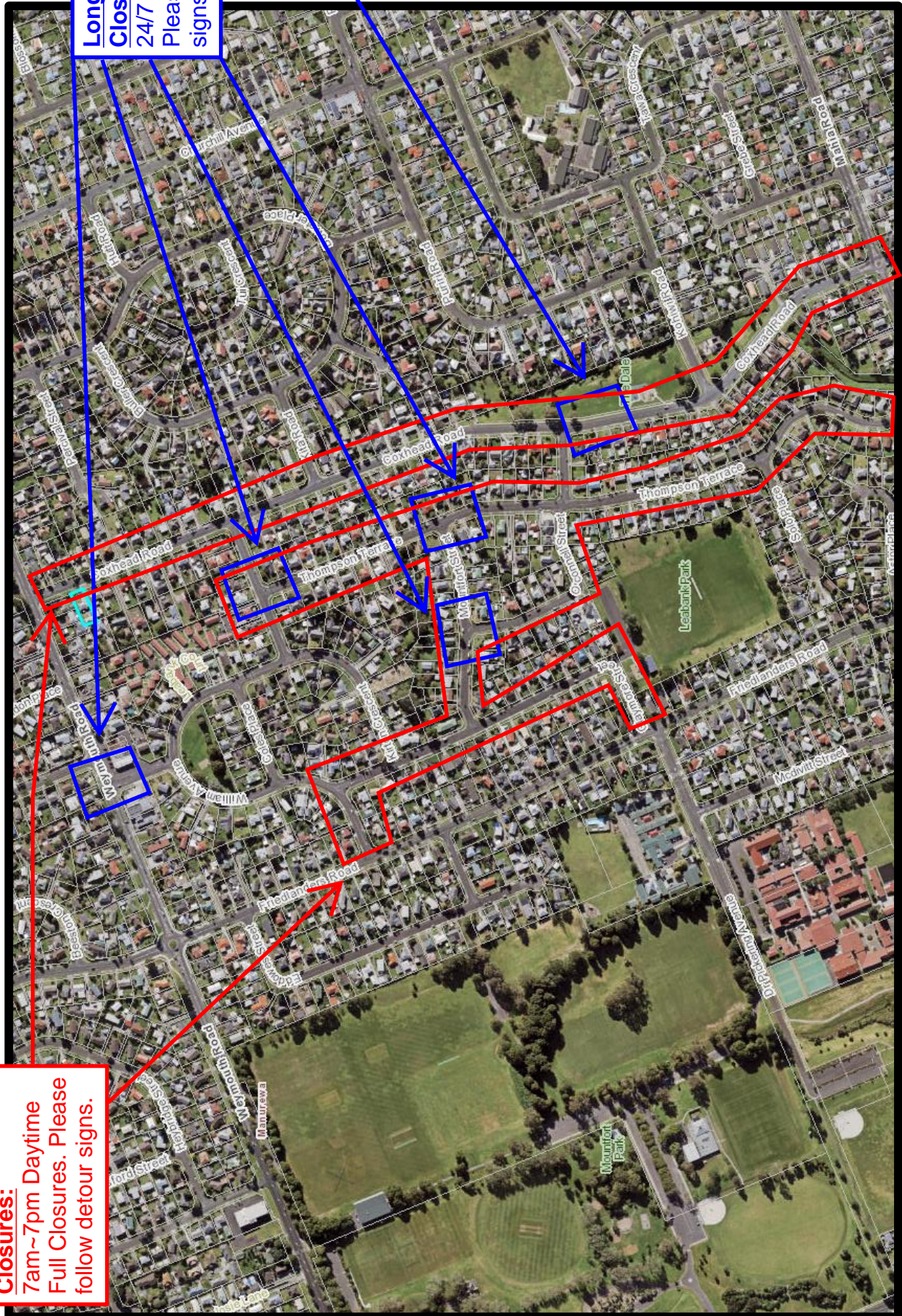
<b>Scheduled start date</b>	1 <sup>st</sup> February 2022 Please note that in the event of bad weather, the start date / duration of this project may change.
<b>Work hours</b>	Day work hours are from 7am – 7pm If night work is needed on your road, you will be notified.
<b>Duration</b>	1 <sup>st</sup> February ~ 31 <sup>st</sup> March 2022
<b>Traffic management</b>	During work hours, temporary traffic management will be in place. This will change as work progresses. This will include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Stop / Go operation</li><li>• Contra-flow operation</li><li>• Road closures</li><li>• Traffic detours</li><li>• Parking restrictions</li><li>• Driveway access restrictions</li></ul> During work hours, traffic controllers will be on site to assist pedestrians and vehicles where required. Please follow all traffic management signage to navigate safely around the worksite.
<b>Street parking</b>	Prior to work starting, cones and no parking signs will be placed on site and remain in place until work is complete.
<b>Driveway access</b>	Driveway access will be restricted at times. Traffic controllers will be on site to assist residents where required. Please expect some delays when machinery is working immediately in front of your driveway. If access restrictions are in place for long periods of time or overnight, residents will be notified individually by a knock on the door or notice in their mailbox.
<b>Pedestrian access</b>	Pedestrian access will be maintained. Please take care when walking in the area. Traffic controllers will be on site to assist pedestrians where required.
<b>Bus stops</b>	During this work, some bus stops will be closed or relocated.
