

Moehau Pest Control Operation

Draft

From 1 July 2021, the Department of Conservation, Whitianga Office, intend to apply cereal baits containing sodium fluoroacetate (1080) over the following Conservation managed land to control pests for the protection of forest ecosystems.

Description of the area

Forest on the Moehau Range north of Waiaro.

Method of control

Cereal baits containing the pesticide will be distributed by helicopter over the area described above and shown in map. The baits are cylindrical pellets 16 mm in diameter, dyed green and cinnamon red.

This pesticide is poisonous to humans and domestic animals.

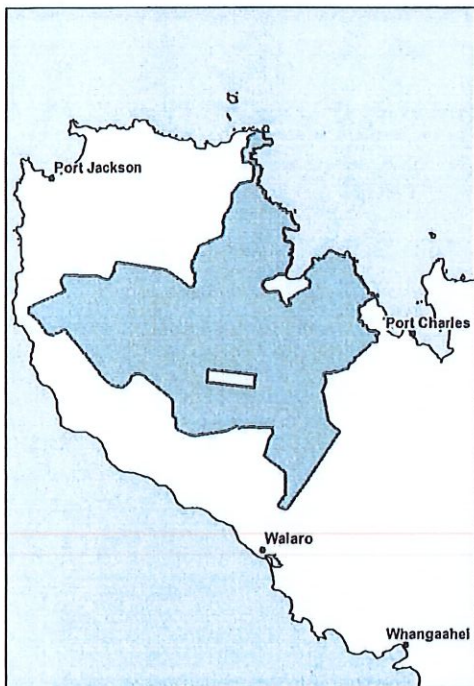
Always remember

- **DO NOT ALLOW DOGS** access to animal carcasses

Observe these rules whenever you see warning signs placed at public access ways in the above area.
