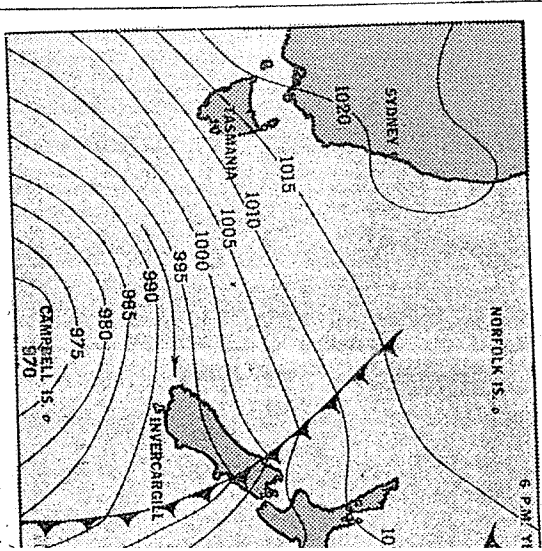

'Venomous' Tactics Alleged

(P.A.) WELLINGTON — Upper Hurt's defeated 76-year-old Mayor farwellled his nine-year-leadship on Saturday night with bitter complaints about election campaign tactics.

Mr Percy Kinsman referred to aspects of the campaign against him as "venomous."

His 1229 votes were about a third of the total cast for the Mayoralty.

His only opponent, Mr George Thomas, aged 63, polled 2720 votes.

"I'm disgusted with the result," he said at a gathering of candidates and wives shortly after final voting figures reached the returning officer.

Mr Kinsman said he had lost all confidence in Upper Hurt's people.

"This is the first time I've had to complain about a campaign," he said.

Mr Thomas was "surprised" at the size of his victory, but sorry that more residents had not voted.

About 50 per cent of the electoral roll voted — an increase of about 4 per cent on the last election.
