Thank you for your Official Information Act (the Act) request of 8 June 2022.

You have asked whether:

- The Internet Archive agreement related to the Overseas Published Collection[s] has been cancelled, or modified or is still running as was previously and;
- If modified, you wish to receive a complete and updated list of the books selected for this agreement.

In response to part one of your request, the National Library is reconsidering its plan for the Overseas Published Collections (OPC). The National Library will not export any of the items in the OPC until it has considered its options for the next steps. I understand that no other items have gone to other National Libraries at this time.
