Commercial information has been withheld in full in accordance with section 7(2)(b)(ii). One email concerning a police report has been withheld in accordance with section 6(2)(a) of the Act.

For completeness, remaining information from various teams has been refused in accordance with section 17(f) of the Act. As it would require wide searches of various officers that dealt with the project to assess for information relevant. This would entail substantial research to identify if contact was had with those relevant to your request. The Manager City Development would however hold key information relevant to your request. If you do believe further information is required based on the information released. We are happy to conduct targeted searches.
