Thank you for your email which sets out the planned exhibition.

Section 197 of the Electoral Act effectively prohibits anything on election day (from midnight to 7pm) which can be said to interfere with or influence voters, including processions, speeches or public statements. This includes exhibiting party names, emblems, slogans or logos.

As your exhibition will be open to the public on election day (20 September 2014), you will need to be careful that you do not display any party logos (recent or historical) or anything that might be perceived as political or associated with a particular party.

Please let me know if you require further clarification on this.
