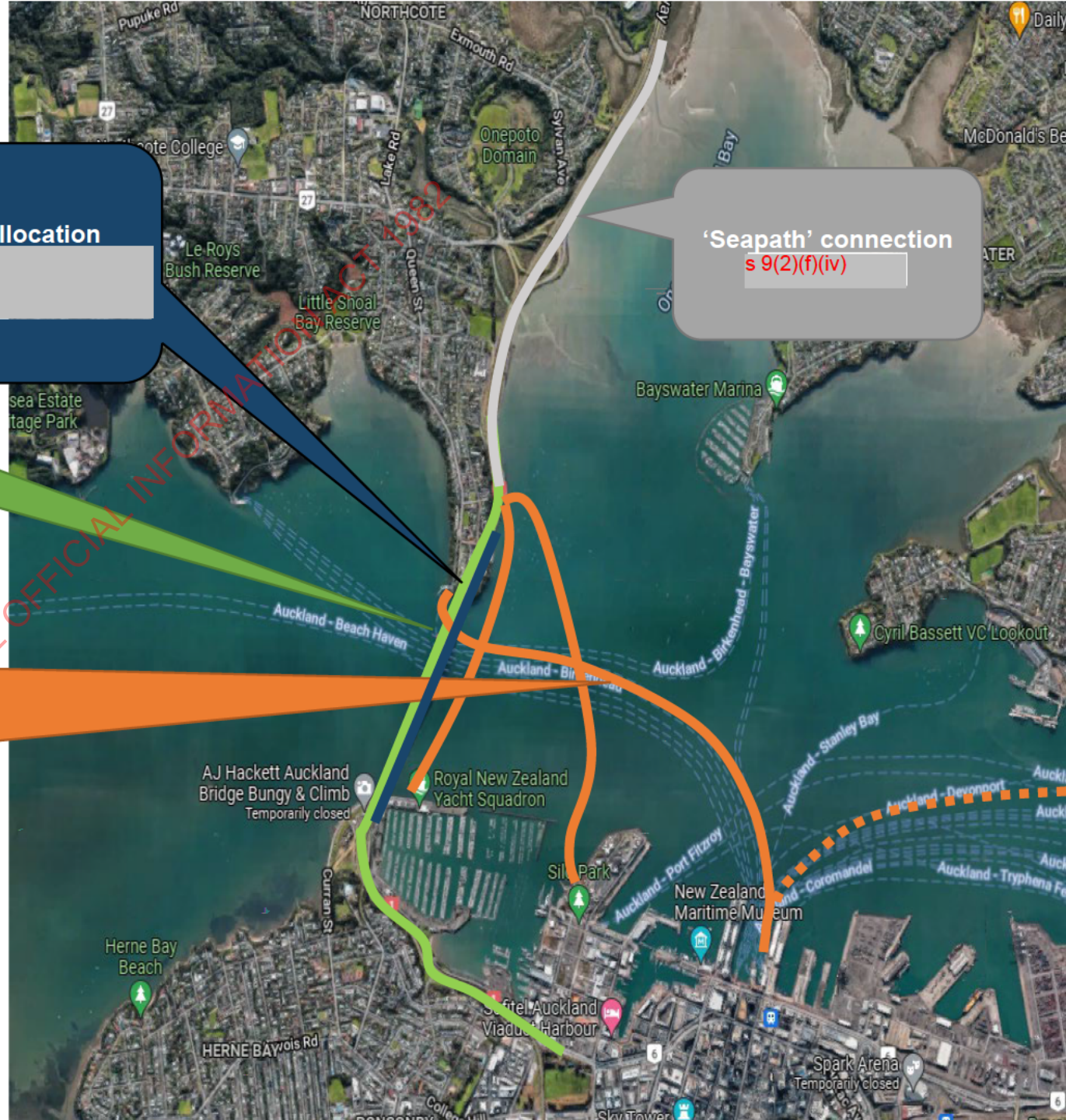

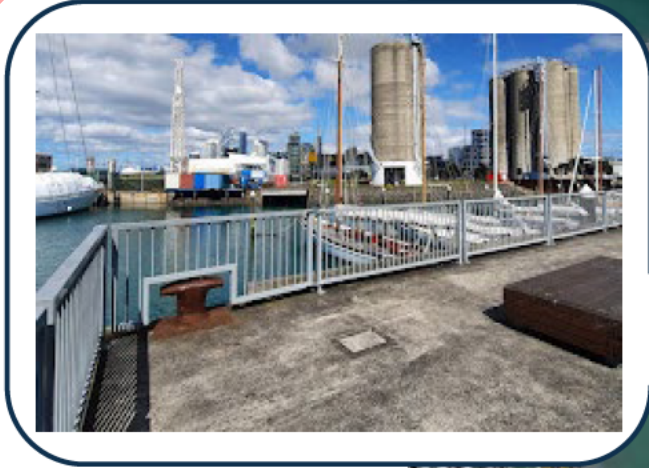

Emerging walking and cycling scope

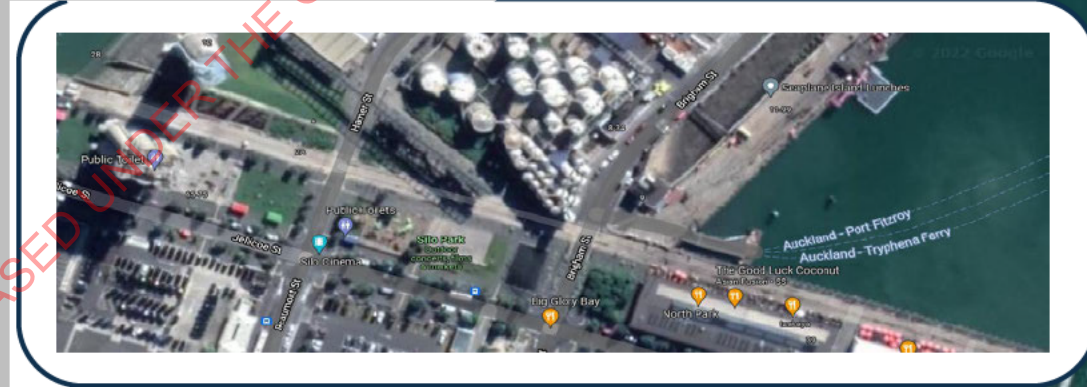
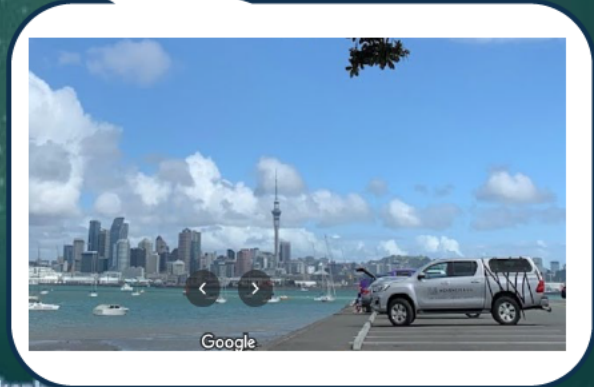
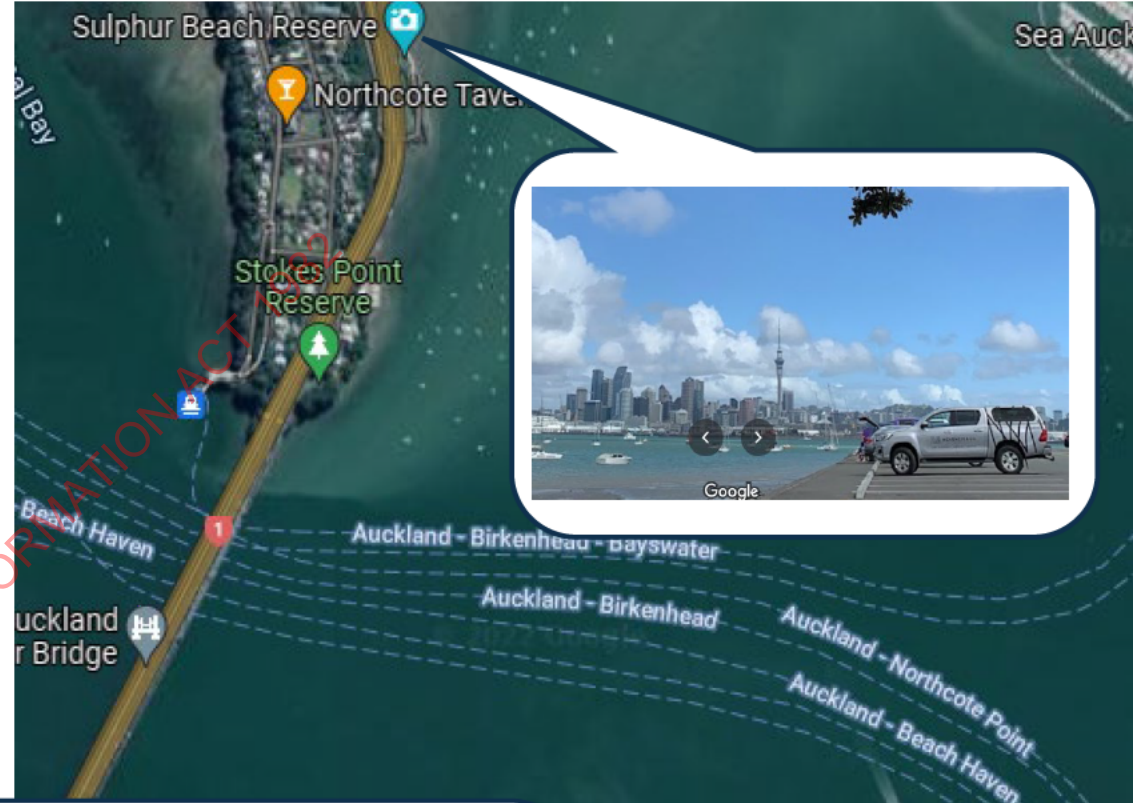
## The emerging option is:

- a ferry route between the Sulphur Beach area and Wynyard
- serviced by custom built, dedicated electric ferries,
- an outdoor, active mode connection with supporting infrastructure
- effectively connecting with future and existing walking and cycling investments.
