INFORMATION REQUEST – Regarding illegal parking during the AIMS games

- **Any interested parties e.g Priority One**

regarding attendees of AIMS games parking on berms along Cameron Road and allowing or granting dispensations for "illegal" parking during events

We have considered your request in accordance with the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 ("**LGOIMA**") and respond as follows:

- There are no records, communication, or meeting notes regarding your request. Illegal parking was not permitted during the AIMS games 2022.


