## Response to your official information request

Thank you for your official information request received on 28 January 2023.

You requested information on vacancies that are still under consideration by the Minister for Land Information where the nomination period has closed, what stage they are currently at and when final decisions are expected.

For those appointments, you requested:

- The advertisement date for nominations.
- The method of advertisement.
- The volume of applications received.
- When the nominations period closed.

You also requested information about appointments where nominations will be called for in 2023.

### Vacancies under consideration

We have interpreted your request to mean vacancies both where:

- The nomination period has closed but are still under consideration by the Minister for Land Information and the terms of previous Board members have expired.
- Vacancies are upcoming, the nomination period has closed and are still under consideration by the Minister for Land Information, but the terms of previous Board members have not yet expired.

Vacancies for appointments to the Cadastral Surveyors Licensing Board (CSLB) and the New Zealand Geographic Board Ngā Pou Taunaha o Aoteaora (NZGB) fall within the scope of your request.

- The CSLB currently has five vacant positions, and two vacancies for substitute members which may be optionally filled by the Minister for Land Information.
- Terms for four of the eight members of the NZGB expire in April 2023.
