On the sheet 'Active standard licence endorse' is listed Endorsement types B,C,F,L,M,P and T

I have found some information on B,C,E and F. What do L,M,P and T stand for?

A complete list of the endorsement types used would be most helpful, incase my current understanding is wrong.

The lettering system used to refer to endorsements and licences, though often used by Police, is an administrative alphabetic approach used to distinguish between each licence and endorsement and are not their correct names. While this alphabetic system has little basis in the Arms Act 1983, the key legislation that informs the arms regulatory system, each licence and endorsement is, in limited circumstances, referred to by its letter rather than its correct name. This administrative approach remains in use, including in the monthly firearms data report you have referenced.

Please find attached to this response a table that lists every licence and endorsement by the administrative letter it is known as, the full name of each, and where further information relating to each can be found.

For your information, Police has developed a process for proactive release of information, so the anonymised response to your request may be publicly released on the New Zealand Police website.
