For comparability with 2023 data, only Semester 1 applicant data has been provided. Includes Domestic - SAC Funded and International Full Fee new to programme applicants and students.

Please note that in 2022, there was a temporary restructure of the admissions process for AUT's clinical health science degrees, with the result that all applicants were referred to another programme. For this reason, 2022 data is not comparable with 2020, 2021, or 2023. We have provided data for 2020, 2021, and 2023, in order to allow for year-on-year comparisons.
