



Appendix One – Fire station developments

Region	Site	Work
Te Hiku	Parnell	A new fire station is currently being built in Parnell, Auckland. Construction is underway and is approximately 70 percent complete. Expected completion is estimated to be October 2024.
Te Hiku	Houhora	The Houhora Fire Station appliance bay was demolished and a new one constructed.
Te Hiku	Whangārei Heads	An appliance bay extension with dedicated locker room space is being built at the Whangārei Heads Fire Station. Construction is due to start 1 July 2024 and is expected to take 4 months.
Te Hiku	Auckland City	Asbestos is being removed throughout Auckland City Fire Station. Expected completion date is estimated to be July or August 2024.
Te Hiku	Ōtara	The Ōtara Fire Station has received a seismic upgrade – it was completed on 27 January 2023.
Ngā Tai ki te Puku	Rotorua – National Training Centre	We're currently renewing the air discharge consent for the National Training Facility in Rotorua with the Bay of Plenty Regional Council, Toi Moana. A planning consultant will update the resource consent application, aiming for completion by December 2024.
Ngā Tai ki te Puku	Tauranga	A business case has been approved for the construction of a six-bay single crew composite fire station. We are currently awaiting the final decision on timing, so we cannot confirm the exact timeline for the new build yet; however, the business case indicated construction could commence within 12-24 months.
Ngā Tai ki te Puku	Ruatoria	The Ruatoria Fire Station underwent seismic and fire upgrades, including emergency lighting improvements, egress route enhancements, and smoke separation, completed in June 2024.
Te Ūpoko	Hastings	The seismic upgrade and refurbishment of the Hastings Fire Station were successfully completed in May 2024.
Te Ūpoko	Trentham	The Trentham Fire Station bedroom upgrade was completed in December 2023
Te Ūpoko	Waverley	The Waverley Fire Station appliance bay extension and locker room extension were completed in June 2024.
Te Ihu	Kaiapoi	A new station has been built in Kaiapoi - this was completed in October 2023.
Te Ihu	Moana	A business case has been approved for seismic strengthening and an extension to Moana Fire Station. We are conducting further feasibility and the timeframe for completion is expected to be July 2025.
