Response to your request for official information

Thank you for your request under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act) to Manatū Hauora (the Ministry of Health) on 6 June 2023 for:

"I believe there is a contractural relationship between MOH or Te Whatu Ora and St John/Wellington Free Ambulance to provide Ambulance services. Could you please provide a list of each of the ambulance stations in NZ with their current earthquake rating (%nbs) at IL4"

Manatū Hauora and Te Whatu Ora – Health New Zealand do not hold any information in scope of your request.
