Collecting up various discussions over the last week and my reflections on them:

I think we should add the following to our list of collected data:

To fixed network providers: For each EU listed, other technologies available and provided by the provider (eg copper, fibre, HFC, FWA, etc) – **note** that we only want technologies over which new connections will be provided

For FWA users: Is an external antenna installed? (Y/N)

For RSPs: A table of their retail services and the technologies they operate over.

I also think that we probably don't need the non-SFA question in TSO data – the TSO doesn't apply in SFAs, so unless we want this as a check, it doesn't tell us much...
