Removal and replacement of existing damaged concrete steps leading to Ding's Bay, Langs Beach with new concrete boxed steps and timber barrier.

Works will improve access to the Bay by replacing unsafe sections of steps and decreasing the gradiant to a less than 75% grade to enable a wider range of users to access this bay safely. The existing track is relatively steep and currently limits less abled users from accessing the Bay.




