1. Minimum average academic mark to receive an offer from the waitlist into the BDS programme commencing in 2020 – 2023 via the HSFY General category

3. The number of BDS applicants for the years 2020 – 2023 that passed the UCAT threshold in each year via the HSFY General category

Subject to the following comments, please see the below table which shows the number of applicants who met the UCAT thresholds and were invited to an interview for entry to the 2020 - 2023 BDS programmes via the HSFY General category:

 To be considered for admission to the BDS programme via the HSFY category, an applicant must have enrolled in the HSFY programme and passed all prescribed papers, at first attempt, and have achieved a minimum average of 70%, with no paper grade less than 65%. Applicants must have a score in all five of the UCAT sections at a threshold level determined annually by the Dental Admissions Committee. Applicants must have also passed the HSFY Diagnostic Test or have passed the ENGL128 paper. Further information on the entry requirements for the BDS programme (including for all categories and sub-categories) is available on the University <u>website</u>.

• Please note that the UCAT thresholds determined by the Dental Admissions Committee are subject to change from year to year, any may not necessarily remain the same each year.
