Please could you provide me with information as to the following:

Who is the NZSL accountable to ie who is the governing body?; and 2. What law enforcement authority does the NZLS have to hold lawyers accountable to New Zealand Law and to the Rules for Lawyers according to the Lawyers & Coveyancers Act?

- The information you have requested is publicly available. I am therefore declining your request under section 18(d) of the Official Information Act 1982 ("OIA").
