



### 1277. Review Draft Investment Framework

The GM Performance Partnership presented the Investment Framework to the Board and acknowledged the contribution of Andrew Matheson and Wayne Maher

The proposed refinements were highlighted noting that all investment decisions would be aligned for the same time.

The Board questioned the outcomes that were trying to be achieved and how they would be measured noting the criteria for investment needed to align with the

outcomes that were trying to be achieved and a consistent measurement tool was required for this.

The GM Performance Partnerships introduced Wayne Maher to the Board who stepped them through examples of performance pathways for Rowing NZ and Cycling NZ.

The Board raised comments in relation to the framework noting that definitions should be clarified and encouraged Management to define "aspirational" clearly so as not to mislead sports. Culturally distinctive pathways were raised noting it was an opportunity to demonstrate how responsibilities under Te Tiriti o Waitangi were being fulfilled.

The Board **noted** the paper and accompanying draft Investment Framework 2022-24 and **agreed** to provide feedback on the draft Investment Framework 2022-24 noting that the Framework would be finalised in February.

Then deferred to 22 April 2021 and approved (paper attached):

# 1324. HPSNZ Investment Framework

The GM Performance Partnership made a presentation to the Board and thanked the Board Sub Committee for their assistance in the process. He highlighted the process to date noting the final Investment Framework and TAPS guidelines incorporate final input from the Board Sub Committee and NSO Feedback and confirmed the next steps through to Dec 2021.

The Board discussed timing given NSO preparation for Tokyo, the return and debrief process, and general NSO capacity. Management noted that work commenced last October, and sports were aware of the timetable and PTLs are working with the sports to support them through the process.

The Board thanked Management and the Sub Committee for their work and noted the paper and accompanying proposed Investment Framework 2021-24, and TAPS Guidelines 2021-24.

The Board agreed to **Approve (1335)** the HPSNZ Investment Framework 2021-24, and HPSNZ TAPS Guidelines 2021-24.

Then in Dec 2021 they approved (paper attached):

## 1435. Paris Investment

The COO introduced the paper to the Board.

The GM Performance Partnerships gave a presentation highlighting the key system shifts and outlined the key campaign changes.

The Board held a discussion on wellbeing as an integral pillar of the strategy and questioned why the wellbeing line in some budgets had \$0 allocated with Management noting that some sports had not applied and some were not clear in what they were doing in this area and it was a requirement for them to be

able to detail what their funding was for. The Board noted that the wellbeing budget should be clarified as TBC noting that Management would cover off wellbeing investment in the letters that are sent out.

The Board noted that where a welfare/wellbeing request had been denied Management should include commentary to explain why it had been declined.

It was further noted that the development of wellbeing initiatives would be ongoing throughout the cycle and it was agreed that further investment would be necessary as these initiatives were developed.

The Board noted the importance of investing in capability and wellbeing and saw that as a critical part of the investment to NSOs.

Investment conditions were discussed with Management noting that the purpose of the investment was not to increase risk in NSOs but that in reality there are going to be capacity and capability issues in some sports.

The Board questioned whether \$6 million additional investment was sufficient noting that this would be a discussion for the Sport NZ Board at their meeting.

The Board noted the cultural pathway and the positive progress in this area.
