May I kindly request the all emails you have send to your nomination service database from 1st Jan 2023 to 12 Jan 2024”.

We have interpreted your request to mean emails advising of board position vacancies and events that were of wide distribution to multiple members on our Nominations Service database, Te Pae Ārahi from 1 January 2023 to 12 January 2024.

- section 9(2)(a) - to protect the privacy of natural persons.
