I refer to your information request dated 22 January 2024 made under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act). You have requested:

“May I please request the 2023 GPA's (and specific point marks) of the following papers:

- *COMP111 (semester 2)*
- *FINC303 (semester 2)”*

Subject to the following comments, please see attached the information you have requested.

- the data is correct as at 12 February 2024.
- we note that the grade and mark distributions for the Semester 2 2023 FINC303 have not been finalised yet as the final grades for some students have not been confirmed. On that basis, we decline this part of your request pursuant to section 18(g) of the Act, as the information requested is not held by the University as at today's date. We would be happy to consider a new request from you at a later date if you still wish to receive this information – we expect that all student grades will be confirmed by late February 2024.
- the attached information contains two tables – one for the mark and grade distribution for the 2023 COMP111 paper, and one for the cumulative 2023 GPA of all students enrolled in the paper. These cumulative GPA calculations will include the results of all papers undertaken in 2023, including COMP111.
- in the attached grade and mark distributions, we note that students who withdrew from the paper are excluded from the data.

I trust that this information will be helpful.

If you are not satisfied with our response to your information request, section 28(3) of the Act provides you with the right to ask an Ombudsman to investigate and review this response. However, we would welcome the opportunity to discuss any concerns with you first.
