#### **Dear James**

Thank you for your email of 14 February 2024 requesting the following information under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act):

I would like to clarify that I am referring to all correspondence from Chris Bishop or his office regarding the use of te reo Māori. This includes instructions on how Kāinga Ora and Te Tūāpapa Kura Kāinga should use te reo Māori in communications to the Minister, how they must use it when communicating to the public, and how they must use it when drafting responses on behalf of the Minister's Office (e.g Letters from the Minister).

I provide you with two emails about the use of te reo Māori. Some information has been withheld under the following sections of the Act:

Section of the Act	Reason to withhold
9(2)(a)	Protect the privacy of natural persons

In terms of section 9(1), I am satisfied that, in the circumstances, the decisions to withhold information under section 9 of the Act is not outweighed by other considerations that render it desirable to make the information available in the public interest.
