Thank you for your email of 6 May 2024 requesting the following information under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act):

I noted, you have recently call for nomination for your tamaki redevelopment company board positions. which closed on 5 May 2024 (today)

May I ask how you called for public nomination and on what platform you have call for public nominations e.g. govt.jobs website. Also, how many applications you have received from the public and how many you have received from other nominating agencies such as TPK or Ministry of women etc for your role. How many you have shortlisted and how many you have interviewed.

This role was advertised on the website of Te Tūāpapa Kura Kaupapa – Ministry of Housing and Urban Development (the Ministry), the Seek online employment marketplace, Auckland Council careers website, and candidates were also notified via The Treasury board appointments database.

Nominations were invited from the Ministry for Women, Office of Ethnic Communities, Te Puni Kōkiri, the Ministry for Pacific Peoples, Whaikaha – the Ministry of Disabled People and from the Government Caucus and coalition parties.

The Ministry received 78 nominations in total -69 self-nominations and nine nominations from nominating agencies and Caucus. The short-listing and interview process has not yet taken place.
