Please can you provide the standard resources used by at Te Whatu Ora that are:

- a) provided to third parties and contractors and that set the expectations that those creating health guidelines are drafted to meet the expected requirements.
- b) used by Te Whatu Ora to appraise health guidelines that are received from the third party / contractors prior to fulfillment of their contract to validate that they meet the expected quality.

## Response

Please can you provide the standard resources used by at Te Whatu Ora that are:

a) provided to third parties and contractors and that set the expectations that those creating health guidelines are drafted to meet the expected requirements.

Service specifications with third parties and contractors outline our expected requirements and are unique written to each procurement process. Therefore, I am declining this part of your request under section 18(e) of the Act as this information does not exist.

b) used by Te Whatu Ora to appraise health guidelines that are received from the third party / contractors prior to fulfillment of their contract to validate that they meet the expected quality.

Guidelines are assessed against the service specifications outlined in the specific contract for the development of the relevant Guideline/s and undergo relevant clinical review and internal clinical approval processes. Standard resources are not provided. Therefore, I am declining this part of your request under section 18(e) of the Act as this information does not exist.
