The voter completed the vote and ticked National Party on the ballot paper and realised was issued with the wrong electorate. Issued with new ballot paper within the voter's electorate. Second voter was issued with the earlier invalid marked ballot paper and posted this on Facebook. Rectified the issue and raised an incident report.

	 An incident at the Waihe Beach community centre Voting Place. It opened an hour late at 11am as the Voting Place Manager (VPM) locked the key centre in the building. Property manager was called to open. Two voters were waiting. The VPM apologised profusely.
