

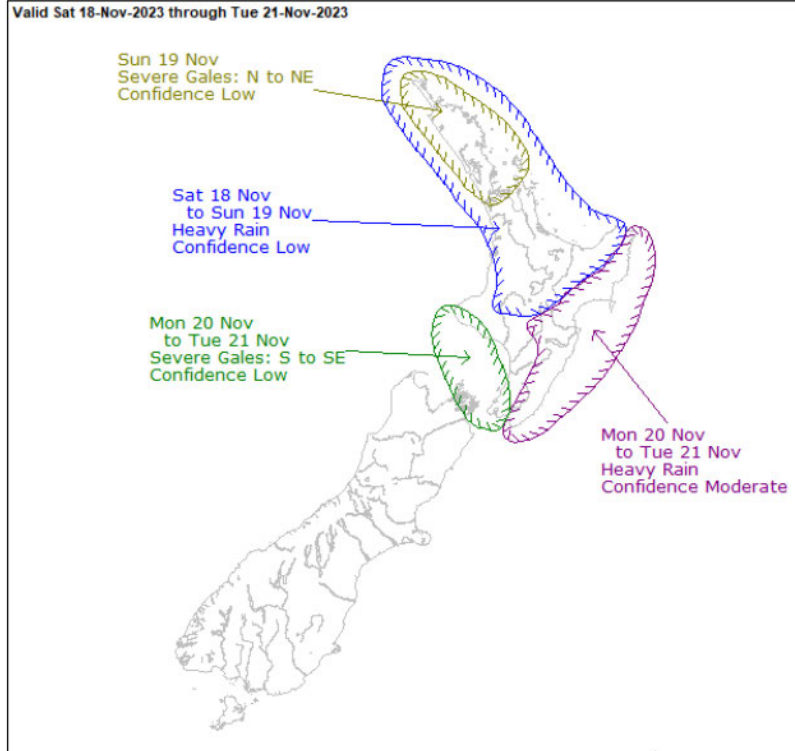

Severe Weather	A low is expected to develop west of the North Island during Friday and deepen on Saturday. The low should move over the North Island during Sunday, although the exact track is a little uncertain at this stage. There is low confidence that a heavy rainfall warning will be needed in Northland, Auckland, Coromandel Peninsula,

Outlook

Waikato, inland Waitomo, Bay of Plenty, Taurarunui and Taupō on Saturday and Sunday. The low may become slow moving north of Bay of Plenty or just east of the North Island on Monday. There is moderate confidence that heavy rain in Tairāwhiti, Hawke's Bay, Taihape and Wairarapa will require a warning on Monday and Tuesday. Strong to gale south to southeast winds are likely about the centre of the country and there is low confidence that a wind warning will be needed in southern Taranaki, Wellington and the Marlborough Sounds on Monday and Tuesday.
