<b>Severe Weather Outlook (Wed 22 Nov – Sat 25 Nov)</b>	A strong southerly flow may reach gale thresholds from Friday through to Sunday morning, impacting Central and northern New Zealand A slow moving low is also forecast to form northeast of the North Island, likely to bring periods of heavy rain to eastern regions of the North Island. There is moderate confidence of warning amounts of rain for northern Hawke's Bay to southern Gisborne from Friday onwards and weather warnings may be issued in these areas.

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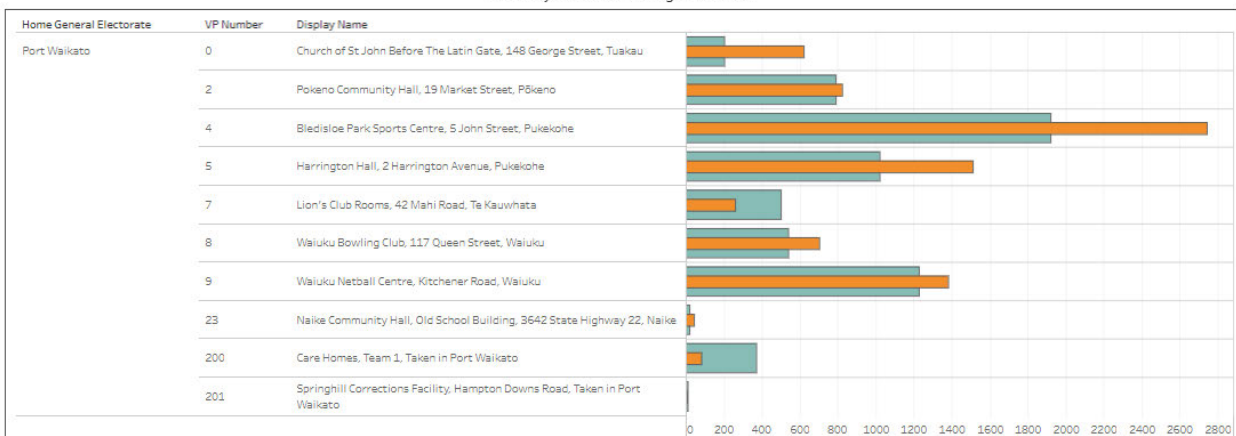
