





Update on proposed Teitei Drive development

Kia ora,

We are writing to you to provide an update about the proposed mixed housing development of 44 homes at Teitei Drive in Ohakune. This development is a partnership between Ruapehu District Council, Kāinga Ora – Homes and Communities and Ngāti Rangi.

As the Teitei Drive development has progressed through detailed design and planning phases, it has become clear that the Crown Infrastructure Partner (CIP) funding will not be sufficient to complete the project as it was originally scoped back in 2021.

This, combined with current market pressures, has meant that the project is no longer financially viable for Käinga Ora and we cannot deliver the affordable housing outcomes as intended.

With this in mind, and after considering multiple options, we have made the difficult decision that it is no longer feasible for Kāinga Ora to proceed with this development. Assum, we will no longer be submitting a resource consent application for enabling works as previously indicated.

While it is not uncommon for the costs to rise once more detailed investigations have been undertaken, we understand that our decision will be disappointing for those in need of housing.

We remain committed to working closely with Ruagehu District Council and Ngāti Rangi to explore opportunities to deliver public and affordable housing, as together we recognise that there is a need for more housing in the Ruapehu District.

FAQ

Q: Why has Kainga Ora decided not to proceed with the proposed development at Teitei Drive?

A: As the Teitei Drive development has progressed through the detailed design and planning phases, it has become clear that the \$5.2 million allocated by the Crown Infrastructure Partners for land development is no longer sufficient to complete the project as originally scoped in 2021.

This, combined with current economic and market pressures, has meant that the project is not financially viable for Kāinga Ora, and we would be unable to deliver the intended affordable housing outcomes.

While we have considered multiple options, it is due to these factors that we have determined it is not feasible for Kāinga Ora to proceed with the project.

Q: Why have you found out now that the costs of the proposed development are higher than initially forecast?

A: Last year, Kainga Ora identified that the land development costs were higher than when the development was originally proposed in 2021.

The proposed masterplan was subsequently reviewed and revised in an effort to reduce costs. An independent quantity surveyor completed a cost assessment at the end of January 2024 based on the latest masterplan and found there would still be significant additional costs required to complete the land development.

Q: What is happening with the resource consentarplication for enabling works Kāinga Ora intended to lodge in February?

A: We will not be submitting a resource consent for enabling works as we had previously signalled.

Q: What is happening with the CIP unding that was allocated to this project?

A: Given this is a very recent desision, we are still working through the terms of the funding agreement with the Crown Infristructure Partners and our project partners.

Q: What are the next steps?

A: Käinga Ora remains committed to working closely with Ruapehu District Council and Ngati Rangi to explore opportunities to deliver public and affordable housing, as together we recognise that the need for housing in Ruapehu District remains.







5./ Please provide budget costs with breakdown that made up the \$5.2m originally anticipated for development, then the budget cost shortfall breakdown discovered between may-jury, and then the same for the budget costs breakdown referred to in letter released Feb 2024 stating the shortfall.'

I refer you to the below responses provided (in OI 23 651) to the Ohakune Residents and Ratepayers' Society Inc in February 2024:

- "5) OIA information released to date discussed a draft agreement between Ngāti Rangi; please elaborate what the agreement provides for? (unless you can provide a copy) Under section 16(1)(e) of the Act, Kāinga Ora is providing the following summary: this Partnership Agreement formalises the relationship between Kāinga Ora and Nga Waihua o Paerangi. This Partnership Agreement sets to establish an ongoing co-operative relationship regarding shared areas of interest between Ngāti Rangi and Kāinga Ora.
- 5a) Does the agreement give preferential access to any of the housing? Question 5a asks whether the informal unsigned agreement will give any preferential access to any of the housing or land?

Kāinga Ora's engagement with Ngāti Rangi is in accordance with the Kainga Ora - Homes and Communities Act 2019. The draft Partnership Agreement does not include provision for houses to be given or allocated to Ngāti Rangi. For the 15 public homes that will be built, the Kāinga Ora specialist placement team matches new homes to applicants on the Ministry of Social Development's Housing Register with the highest priority for a home of that size and in that location.

5b) Does the agreement provide any incentive for Ngāti Rangi to have become a partner to the Teitei Dr project? The agreement has been discussed as saying the two additional lots were not specifically listed, which could be considered that different wording could have been used, such as "additional lots over and above the 44 lots" could be allocated to Ngati Rangi. No incentive is provided. Ngāti Rangi are Mana Whenua of the area of the development project. Kāinga Ora's engagement with Ngāti Rangi is in accordance with the Kainga Ora - Homes and Communities Act 2019. The draft Partnership Agreement does not include provision for houses to be given or allocated to Ngāti Rangi.

There is no agreement with Kāinga Ora for houses to be given or allocated to Ngāti Rangi."

We have also provided updates via email, website, social media, and through one-to-one conversations. The Kāinga Ora electronic search function cannot produce results in the form requested, as it will capture any key word used in a search (i.e. Napier and Ruapehu, or Teitei and Napier search terms used together capture any of the search terms used - so an email containing one of the terms will be captured in search results).

Given the limitations of our electronic search, more than 9,000 entails were returned as potentially being in scope. This volume of correspondence could conservatively amount to 20,000 pages of material (excluding attachments) that would need to be assessed, prepared and consulted on before any information could be released.

Providing the information sought would involve a providive amount of manual collation and remove staff from core duties for a substantial period of time and as a result, the greater public interest in the effective and efficient administration of the public service would not be served. Therefore, your request is refused under section 18(f) of the Act, that the information requested cannot be made available without substantial collation or research.

An electronic search carried out identified 8,705 emails potentially in scope of this part of the request. This volume of correspondence could conservatively amount to 19,000 to 20,000 pages of material (excluding attachments) that would need to be assessed, prepared and consulted on before any information could be released.

Providing the information sought would involve a prohibitive amount of manual collation and remove staff from core duties for a substantial period of time and as a result, the greater public interest in the effective and efficient administration of the public service would not be served. I do not consider the withholding of information from this response is outweighed by the public interest considerations in making that information available.
