#### Hi Suzanne and Patrick

Following up on my conversation with Suzanne this morning. Noting our previous correspondence regarding shifting the SGA loading in the model from Eastern Hutt Road to Kiln Road, we have now updated and finalised the reporting. As part of the reporting update we noted that one of the Silverstream development zones was loading into the model in the vicinity of Wallaceville which has also been corrected in the attached report. This only had a minor impact on model results.

Key changes arising from both of these corrections are as follows:

- All figures and tables relating to Scenario 2 and Scenario 3 have been updated, as well as the proceeding discussion.
- Small increase in total vehicle minutes and vehicle kilometres for Scenario 2&3. Most pronounced in 2033.
- Minor changes to LOS totals by intersection and by km. Key intersections will be discussed later.
- Small drop in Eastbound traffic on Fergusson Dr (West) in 2043 AM peak (Sc2: 1174 down to 1117, Sc3: 1204 down to 1130). Same for Westbound in PM Peak (Sc2: 1084 down to 1029, Sc3: 1106 down to 1041). This pattern continues throughout the future years.
- Barley Mow Ln no longer showing up with LoS issues due to SGA traffic being moved onto Kiln St.
- Brentwood St/ Tawai St/ Fergusson Dr shows LoS E in Sc2 & Sc3 in the 2043 PM peak as opposed to only Sc2 previously.
- Extent of LOS F in the 2053 PM peak on SH2 by Moonshine Rd decreases.

As such the changes are minor but is good to finalise and lock down the report.



Hi All

Happy New Year. We have re-run the 2053 conservative scenario with the full SGA loaded in the vicinity of Kiln Street. Looking back we had it split 50/50 between accessing Eastern Hutt Road directly and being loaded into Silverstream so the impact of the test is to move 375 lots only back into Silverstream.

The model is not picking up any additional Level of Service issues at the key roundabouts with delays changing by no more than a few seconds. However, we have observed the following changes:

- -the right turn issue onto Eastern Hutt Road as a result of the direct access has disappeared.
- -Field Street from Fergusson Drive to Kiln Street has deteriorated in both morning and evening peak from LoS C to LoS D as shown below (morning is on left and evening on right).



As before a more detailed model (such as a Sidra Intersection model) may highlight issues on roundabout intersection approaches.

Please advise if you require further action or reporting on this test.
