I refer to your information request dated 27 June 2024 made under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act). You have requested mark and grade distributions for the Health Sciences First Year (HSFY) papers offered by the University of Otago in Semester 1 2024 (CELS191, CHEM191, HUSB191, PHSI191).

We note your clarification email of 4 July 2024, in which you advised you were interested in receiving the information limited to domestic students enrolled in the HSFY programme only.

The grade and mark distributions for the Semester 1 2024 HSFY papers have not been finalised yet as the final grades for some students have not been confirmed. On that basis, we decline your request pursuant to section 18(g) of the Act, as the information requested is not held by the University as at today's date. We would be happy to consider a new request from you at a later date if you still wish to receive this information.

If you are not satisfied with our response to your information request, section 28(3) of the Act provides you with the right to ask an Ombudsman to investigate and review this response. However, we would welcome the opportunity to discuss any concerns with you first.
