




Barriers to higher State sector productivity

- 1. An absence of demand from leaders and Ministers for productivity measures
- 2. Hostility to the concept of productivity and measurement by Ministers
- 3. Closed and risk-averse agency cultures
- 4. Narrow commissioning and poor policy practices
- 5. Input controls, input-based and restrictive funding
- 6. Budget processes that revald volumes and inputs
- 7. Patchy monitoring, evaluation and use of data

How to move to a more productive State

- Set clearer expectations for productivity
- Build the capability to measure, and measure more
- Report on core public service efficiency
- Use performance measures wisely
- Raise the bar on new spending in the budget
- Pay for results, not inputs
- Improve agency performance

How productivity works



This model has two drivers of productivity growth:

- The spread of technology, ideas and practices (diffusion); and
- The movement of labour and financial resources (reallocation)
- The ability of a firm to improve it's productivity by taking up technology diffusion is a function of the firm's 'absorptive capacity' or the ability to internalise external knowledge.

TRIGGERS FOR PERMISSIONS CONSULTATION WITH NELSON MARLBOROUGH CONSERVATION BOARD

Agreed by the Nelson Marlborough Conservation Board on 28 February 2010 Reviewed by Permissions Committee ... December 2020

Triggers for consultation

The Department of Conservation will consult the Nelson Marlborough Conservation Board for advice through the Board's Permissions Committee on individual permission applications if one or more of the following apply:

- The activity may have a significant impact on conservation values (biodiversity, cultural, historic, recreation and/or landscape) or on other users at the location(s).
- The application may be of particular public or community concern.
- The activity is a significant departure from corrent activity in type and/or scale.
- Where the applicant has a previous record of non-compliance.
- The activity is inconsistent with or not considered by the Conservation Management Strategy, a National Park Management Plan or Conservation Management Plan.

Principles

The following principles apply in general to the role of the Permissions Committee in providing advice to the Department

- Generally the Committee would expect to be consulted on and provide advice only where exceptions apply i.e. where there is perceived risk or the potential for an application to impact significantly on conservation values.
- It's accepted the Department has processes in place to manage Permissions and the Roard expects the Department to carry out this work for routine applications or renewals.

Process for consultation

When one or more of the triggers applies, Committee members will each receive by email a summary of the application with an explanation of which trigger(s) apply and why the Department is seeking the Committee's advice. The Committee Convenor will aim to compile and send a response within 10 days. Emails will generally be sent and received via the Board Support Officer.

Permissions vs concessions

What's the difference?


- Concessions are a particular form of authorisation issued under Part 3B of the Conservation Act 1987
- ► Concessions are required for a wide range of activities on public conservation land, e.g.
 - Guding
 - **-**Events
 - Filming
 - Beehives
 - Infrastructure
 - Wild animal control operations

Permissions vs concessions

What's the difference?

- Some activities do not require a<u>concession</u> but do require permits or authorisations urder other legislation, e.g.
 - Research and lection on public conservation land
 - Holding, catching, handling or releasing wildlife
 - Marie mammal watching
 - Scientific research in marine reserves
 - Mining

Collectively, we call concessions and other forms of permits and authorisations "permissions"




Processing applications

- ▶ Process for concessions (Part 3B of Conservation Act) is generally more prescriptive than for other permissions, e.g. under Wildlife Act
- ► DOC needs to consider purpose for which the land is held, General Policy, statutory planning documents (e.g. CMS, National Park Management Plans), and effects of proposed activity
- Decisions are usually made by the Operations Manager for area where the activity is to occur, but...
- ▶ Decision-making role can be elevated (e.g. to Director); and decision-maker for 'multi-region' or national applications will often be from another DOC region

DOC's process



Why consult with NMCB?

- No reference to consultation in Part B of Conservation Act (but some applications require public notification)
- No reference to consultation for authorisations under National Parks Act, Reserves Act or Wildlife Act

However:

- Conservation Boards have function to advise the Director-General on any other conservation matter relating to any area within the jurisdiction of the Board"
- Consultation allows us to gather information to contribute to decision-making processes, and make better decisions

Triggers for consultation with Nelson Marlborough Conservation Board

- Agreed by the NMCB February 2019, reviewed by Permissions Committee December 2020
- The activity may have a significant impact on conservation values (biodiversity, cultural, historic, receation and/or landscape) or on other users at the location(s).
- The application maybe of particular public or community concern.
- The activity is a significant departure from current activity in type and/or scale.
- here the applicant has a previous record of non-compliance.
- The activity is inconsistent with or not considered by the Conservation
 Management Strategy, a National Park Management Plan or Conservation
 Management Plan.

Process for consultation

- When one or more of the triggers applies, Committee members will each receive by email a summary of the application with an explanation of which trigger(s) apply and why the Department is seeking the Committee's advice.
- The Committee Convenor will aim to compile and send a response within 10 days.
- Emails will generally be sent and received via the Board apport Officer.

A note about consultation / engagement with iwi

- ▶ Do not have agreed 'triggers' for consultation with iwi
- ▶ Can't make assumptions what is/is not of interest
- ▶ Engage iwi on almost all applications (very limited exceptions)
- Weekly email with details of permissions that we are seeking comment on
- Allow 20 working days for comments/feedback but may be extended upon request

What happens with what you tell us?

- ► Comments received through consultation are included in a 'Decision Support Document' prepared for the decision-maker
- Staff make recommendation to decision-maker based on assessment against received through consultation
- Decision-maker must consider all relevant information and may accept or reject recommendation from staff, with reasons
- A lication may be approved or declined
- Permissions that are approved are subject to terms & conditions (some standard, some specific to the activity/place)

Feedback once a decision is made

- ▶ DOC should provide feedback on each application where the Permissions Committee year consulted
- ► What was the decision? How were views of the Permissions Committee take into account?
- We also provide a quarterly summary of <u>all</u> decisions made (whether the Permissions Committee was consulted or not)

Monitoring of permissions

- ▶ We don't have the capacity to monitor every permission that's granted
- ▶ Aim to monitor 5-15% Oconcessions each year
- Also monitor as election of other permissions, particularly marine marrinal watching permits
- ▶ Priorities determined at regional and district level
- Monitoring may be of the activity as it is happening (e.g. on the-ground inspections, 'mystery shopper' trips) or by desktop checks of activity returns
- ▶ Typically checking for compliance with conditions of consent

Permissions compliance

Dealing with illegal operations

- Departing without a permit OR Operating under a permit but outside of its limits
- ▶ DOC Operations staff look out for non-compliant activity and report it via our central compliance database.
- ▶ We also respond public reports of suspected illegal activity.
- ▶ DOC's National Compliance Team has a specialist concessions team that investigates more serious suspected illegal activity. Sometimes results in prosecution.
- Less serious matters are addressed by local Operations staff.
- ▶ Infringement Notices can be issued for certain things eg. drones, dogs, whitebait offences.

TRIGGERS FOR PERMISSIONS CONSULTATION WITH NELSON MARLBOROUGH CONSERVATION BOARD

Agreed by the Nelson Marlborough Conservation Board on 28 February 2010 Reviewed by Permissions Committee 11 June 2024

Triggers for consultation

The Department of Conservation will consult the Nelson Marlborough Conservation Board for advice through the Board's Permissions Committee on individual permission applications if one or more of the following apply:

- The activity may have a significant impact on conservation values (biodiversity, cultural, historic, recreation and/or landscape) or on other users at the location(s).
- The application may be of particular public or community concern.
- The application is being publicly notified.
- The application is for an access arrangement under the Crown Minerals Act.
- The activity is a significant depart for from current activity in type and/or scale.
- Where the applicant has a previous record of non-compliance.
- The activity is inconsister with or not considered by the Conservation Management Strategy, a National Hark Management Plan or Conservation Management Plan.

Principles

The following principles apply in general to the role of the Permissions Committee in providing advice to the Department:

- Los accepted the Department has processes in place to manage Permissions and the board has confidence in the staff undertaking this work. The Board expects the Department to carry out this work in a fair and reasonable way and to follow best practice decision-making.
- The Permissions Committee expects to be consulted, and to provide advice, where the above triggers apply.

Process for consultation

When one or more of the triggers applies, Committee members will each receive by email a summary of the application with an explanation of which trigger(s) apply and why the

Department is seeking the Committee's advice. The Committee Convenor will aim to compile and send a response within 10 working days. Emails will generally be sent and received via the Board Support Officer.

Other matters

The Department typically sends a weekly email to the iwi of Te Tauihu with details of applications that iwi are being invited to comment on that week. These emails will be forwarded to the Permissions Committee for information only.

At 6-monthly intervals, the Department will provide the Permissions Committee with a nent w. g from the official into man. summary of permissions applications received and processed over the previous 6 months, with commentary on any trends or emerging issues. Upon request, the Department will convene a meeting with the Permissions Committee to discuss any matters arising from the summary
