INFORMATION REQUEST

On 5 August 2024 you asked for information about petitions. Here is our response to your questions:

Please kindly provide any communications since 01 April 2024 regarding petitions for boat ramp parking charges and/or a proposed CBD rainbow crossing.

We carried out an email search using the search term 'Boat ramp parking petition' for the period from 1 April 2024 – 5 August 2024. We attach a copy of the communications we retrieved. We have removed duplicates, providing the final email in each chain.
