**RE: OFFICIAL INFORMATION REQUEST**

Thank you for your email of 25 May 2012 in which you made a request for information. This response is issued in accordance with the provisions of the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 (the Act).

As requested, please find attached a copy of Council's current organisation chart. This chart lists the positions, and numbers of staff in those positions, along with the full time equivalent (FTE) numbers for each Group for the 2011/12 financial year.

You have also asked to be provided with any briefings, reports advice, transcripts, notes, correspondence etc regarding any proposal to amalgamate the Council with neighbouring councils. I can advise that at this stage there are no proposals to amalgamate Kāpiti Coast District Council with neighbouring councils. On that basis I must decline this part of your request as the information you have requested does not exist (Section 17(e) of the Act refers).

However, in common with other councils in the Wellington region, the Council is about to canvass support for a range of options for local government reorganisation in the region. You may be interested in viewing the following two documents which will be available from service centres, libraries and the Council's website at [www.kapiticoast.govt.nz](http://www.kapiticoast.govt.nz) from 25 June 2012:

- A discussion document regarding this issue;
- A summary of that discussion document which is designed to be delivered to every household in the district on 22/23 June.

Finally, I note that you have the right to make a complaint under section 27(3) of the Act to an Ombudsman, to seek an investigation and review of this response.
