I refer to your information request dated 8 October 2024 made under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act):

... Secondly, I am requesting the grade distribution for the overall internal mark of all students enrolled in Semester 1 Jurisprudence LAWS302, 2024.

Finally, I am requesting the grade distribution of all student's marks for the LAWS302 Semester 1 Wai 2700 Mana Wahine inquiry 2024. That is, the grade distribution for this particular assignment of the internal assessment for LAWS302, (in addition to the grade distribution of the overall marks for all the internal assessment from LAWS302).

For all three requests I am asking for the specific percentage grades, not letter grades.

We note that the grade and mark distributions for the paper and assignments for 2024 LAWS302 (which is a full year paper) have not been finalised yet as the final grades for some students have not been confirmed. On that basis, we decline this part of your request pursuant to section 18(g) of the Act, as the information requested is not held by the University as at today's date. We would be happy to consider a new request from you at a later date if you still wish to receive this information.

If you are not satisfied with our response to your information request, section 28(3) of the Act provides you with the right to ask an Ombudsman to investigate and review this response. However, we would welcome the opportunity to discuss any concerns with you first.
