Thank you for your email of 8 October 2024 to the Ministry of Business, Innovation and Employment (MBIE) requesting, under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act), the following:

- 1, student visa holder
- 2. Residence visa holder
- 3. Permanent visa holder
- 4. Permanent residency visa holder who applied for citizenship
- 5. Migrant Exploitation Protection Work Visa

On 11 October 2024, we advised you that question 4 of your request was transferred to the Department of Internal Affairs (DIA), in accordance with section 14(b)(ii) of the Act.

MBIE has assessed and decided to grant your request, and will provide you the requested information. However, it will take us some time to process. We will send you the information as soon as it is ready and without undue delay.
