Thank you for your email of 25 September 2024 in which you request the following under the Official Information Act 1982 (OIA):

"I request a list of any aides-mémoire, briefings, memos, notes, reports, or any other advice, if any, you or your Office received between 29 August and today, listed by agency, title and date received."

Please accept my apologies for the delay in responding to you.

I am refusing your request in part under section 18(d) of the Act, as some of the information requested is publicly available through my responses to written parliamentary questions. You can access these responses here:

Of the 19 titles previously withheld in my responses to these questions, I am now releasing a further 11 titles to you in full. However, eight titles must continue to be withheld under section 9(2)(f)(iv) of the Act, to maintain the constitutional conventions for the time being which protect the confidentiality of advice tendered by Ministers of the Crown and officials.

Between 29 August 2024 and 25 September 2024, I also received 18 briefings from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade, in my capacity as Minister for Climate Change. The list of titles can be found in Annex 1. Four titles in scope of your request have been withheld in full under the following sections of the OIA:

- 6(a): to avoid prejudicing the security or defence of New Zealand or the international relations of the New Zealand Government;
- 9(2)(f)(iv): to protect the confidentiality of advice tendered by Ministers of the Crown and officials:
- 9(2)(g)(i): to protect the free and frank expression of opinions by departments; and
- 9(2)(j): to avoid prejudice to negotiations.

Where the information has been withheld under section 9 of the OIA, no public interest in releasing the information has been identified that would override the reasons for withholding it.
