I refer to your request for information dated 15 October 2024 made under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act). You have requested:

"I was wanting information arround the paper PHTY 353 and the discussion arround removing it from the batchelor of physiotherapy programme."

The School of Physiotherapy has confirmed that PHTY353 is not being discontinued, and therefore there are no plans to remove it from the Bachelor of Physiotherapy (BPhty) programme.

On that basis, we decline your request pursuant to section 18(g) of the Act, as the information you have requested is not held by the University, and there are no reasonable grounds to believe it is held by, or more closely connected with the functions of, another agency subject to the Act.
